1. Versions and included files

Component	Current version / included files
BTC Operating System	v1.0.9 — Customer Handbook, Public Evidence Brief, BTC Proof Brief, BTC Deep Test Report, BTC Fit, FAQ & Contribution Guide, and Companion Tracker.
XRP Top/Bottom Indicator	v1.4.3 — Customer Handbook, Public Evidence Brief, Deep Test Report, Deep Test Tearsheet, and Weekly Strategy Tracker.
Bundle layer	BTC + XRP Bundle Evidence Brief, Capital Architecture Brief, Weekly Operating Model Guide, and Combined Operating Guide.

2. What customers should verify first

- The BTC proof stack now includes the Handbook, Public Evidence Brief, BTC Proof Brief, BTC Deep Test Report, BTC Fit, FAQ & Contribution Guide, and Companion Tracker — all under the same BTC v1.0.9 release identity.
- The included workbooks, handbook references, and support files now point to the BTC v1.0.9 / XRP v1.4.3 public document family rather than older BTC references.
- The XRP evidence layer continues to include the Public Evidence Brief, Deep Test Report, timing-protected Deep Test Tearsheet, and Weekly Strategy Tracker.
- The bundle policy layer remains the Combined Operating Guide plus the Capital Architecture and Bundle Evidence briefs.

- Cold-storage onboarding guidance still appears in the BTC and XRP handbooks and is reinforced in the Weekly Operating Model and Combined Operating Guide.
- BTC v1.0.9 is a maintenance release: the public dashboard stays visually familiar, the core weekly BTC engine stays intact, and the customer guidance / alert-version surface is cleaner.
- XRP keeps both a named reminder alert and an Any alert() exact-message path. Treat the named path as the reminder layer and Any alert() as the exact weekly order layer until the BTC/XRP weekly alert surfaces are unified further.
- Default buying path remains BTC first: BTC is the reserve-core weekly system, while XRP is the optional amplifier sleeve for governed cycle participation.

Fast verification check: current versions across the handbooks and proof briefs, current workbook names in the included pack, and one clean document set that reads as a single current release.
