This sheet is for the first 10 minutes, the first week, and the first month. Run the BTC workflow on the supported 1W chart, keep the written policy simple, and let the confirmed weekly close do the heavy lifting.

Default operating model

The sanctioned base workflow

Choose Weekly budget, Cash at Start date, Strategy, Risk level, and Start date -> review ACTION plus the suggested amount after the confirmed weekly close -> execute or hold on-policy -> record the week in the Companion Tracker -> repeat next week. Alerts are optional; the weekly close routine is still the core workflow.

Your first 10 minutes

| Step | What to do |
|------|--|
| 1 | Confirm invite-only access on the correct TradingView account. |
| 2 | Open INDEX:BTCUSD on the 1W chart with regular candles. If it is unavailable, use the longest clean-history BTCUSD or XBTUSD chart you can access. |
| 3 | Add the indicator and keep the starting defaults intact until the first few clean closes are recorded. |
| 4 | Enter Weekly budget, Cash at Start date, Strategy, Risk level, and Start date so the dashboard reflects the real chapter. |

| Step | What to do |
|------|--|
| 5 | Choose one live alert path you will actually use: Any alert() weekly-guidance email, Weekly Update plus optional Major Cycle Event, or manual dashboard review only. |
| 6 | Have the Companion Tracker ready before the next confirmed weekly close. |

Your first week

- Treat quiet periods and HOLD weeks as normal. This is a weekly operating system, not a constant-fire signal feed.
- Do not spend the first week curve-fitting the settings against old history. Stable inputs are part of the proof discipline.
- If the dashboard shows SET TF: 1W, SET SYMBOL: BTC, CHECK FEED, START: FUTURE, DATA: LIMITED, or a persistent STATUS: SAFE warning, fix that before trusting the numbers.
- Keep the workflow narrow: regular candles, the supported 1W BTC chart, one written playbook, one recordkeeping path.

What is normal vs what needs attention

| Normal | Needs attention |
|--|---|
| Long quiet stretches, HOLD weeks, modest suggested amounts, and the benchmark multiple moving over time. | Wrong timeframe, wrong BTC chart family, future Start date, limited data, or alerts that no longer match the live chart settings. |

First month priorities

- Start with Adaptive / Conservative unless you already know why another mode fits your written plan better.
- Use the benchmark as accountability, not ego. A disciplined policy can still have weeks where blind auto-buy does better.
- If trims create confusion, simplify the playbook instead of forcing extra complexity.
- Keep the custody path clear for any long-term BTC you plan to keep. The operating system is non-custodial decision support, not execution or wallet software.
