

XRP Top/Bottom Indicator Alert Setup Card

Version v1.1.0

The rule that matters most

Create alerts on **BITSTAMP:XRPUSD** on the **1W** chart and select the named condition. Do not use a generic catch-all alert option when the indicator already exposes specific alert conditions.

Correct triggers

Condition	Trigger	Why
MAJOR TOP	Once Per Bar Close	Weekly-close confirmation.
RADAR TOP	Once Per Bar Close	Keep active beside MAJOR TOP; the first confirmed top-side print is the practical call.
MAJOR BOTTOM	Once Per Bar Close	Core bottom-side anchor.
RADAR BOTTOM	Once Per Bar Close	Optional tactical add / secondary bottom confirmation path.
EARLY TOP / EARLY BOTTOM	Once Per Bar or Once Per Minute	Optional intrabar heads-up layer only.
LIGHT TOP / LIGHT BOTTOM	Once Per Bar Close	Optional weekly-close context.
RISK (XRP) / RISK (non-XRP)	Once Per Bar Close	Caution layer for trims, tighter risk, and smaller adds.

Default alert stack for most customers

Default stack

Keep **XRP RISK**, **MAJOR TOP**, **RADAR TOP**, and **MAJOR BOTTOM** live together. Add **RADAR BOTTOM** only if your playbook allows tactical adds. Add **EARLY** or **LIGHT** only if you intentionally want extra heads-up context.

Naming convention

- Use literal names: **XRP RISK 1W**, **XRP MAJOR TOP 1W**, **XRP RADAR TOP 1W**, and **XRP MAJOR BOTTOM 1W**.
- If you automate or manage multiple sleeves, include the sleeve name in the alert title.
- If you edit settings that affect what can print, recreate the live alerts afterwards.

Common mistakes

- Setting alerts on the wrong timeframe or the wrong XRP venue.
- Choosing a generic alert option instead of the indicator's named condition.
- Using **Once Per Bar Close** on **EARLY**, or using an intrabar trigger on a weekly-close confirmation alert.
- Expecting XRP-style top / bottom confirmations on non-XRP charts or non-canonical XRP venues.
- Forgetting that TradingView alerts continue using the settings that existed when the alert was created.

Best default stack in one sentence

Best default stack

For tops, keep **XRP RISK**, **MAJOR TOP**, and **RADAR TOP** on together and act on the first confirmed condition that advances your written top-side ladder at the weekly close. For bottoms, use **MAJOR BOTTOM** as the base anchor and treat **RADAR BOTTOM** as optional.
